CHECKER MOTORS COR-PORATION DISPLAYS AT AUTO SHOWS by Byron Babbish

As I write this it is the time of year for the Detroit International Auto Show, a very important event in Detroit that is always held in January. This is one of those annual automobile shows in major cities such as Detroit, Chicago, New York and Los Angeles you read about where the car manufacturers display their current models and often unveil new models or concept cars, and the public can come view them all under one roof. I presume that they are held largely to generate sales in an unusually slow sales time of year. I have many pleasant memories of visiting the Detroit Auto Show (now called the Detroit International Auto Show) at Cobo Hall in downtown Detroit over the years, first with my father, then with friends, and most recently with my children.

I have always wondered if Checker Motors Corporation was ever an active participant on the national auto show circuit. I have been asking Checker Car Club members this question over the years and the only positive response I have ever received was that someone recalled seeing a Checker display at the New York Auto Show in the early 1960's. This would make sense as New York was a huge market for Checker's taxi models and you would think they would like to try to tap or create a retail market there for their Marathons too. No one ever recalled seeing Checkers at any other auto show, until now.

At the 2009 Ypsilanti Orphan Car Show my wife Elaine and I had our two Checkers on display along with Pete Talinca and Ben Merkel with two of their Checkers. One of the many visitors we had at the Checker display that day was John Stewart of Detroit, whom I had never met before.

John and I struck up a conversation and during it he mentioned that he was a professional photographer and used to take photographs at the Detroit Auto Shows. John then mentioned that he recalled seeing a Checker exhibit at one such show and that he even took photographs of it. He said he thought he still had the prints and I expressed interest in them if

he had them.
That winter John
emailed me and
said he found the
prints and was
mailing them to
me.

The photographs he took were great. Checker had two Marathons on display, a sedan and a station wagon. In addition, they had a bodiless frame on display. What looks like three Checker representatives were there, dressed in dark suits wearing name tags.

John re-



calls the convention being held at the old Convention Hall on Woodward Avenue in Detroit and guesses that the date was 1959 to 1961. In John's own words, "As a young photographer attending the Auto Show at the old Detroit Convention Hall on Woodward, I was approached by a man at the Checker Motors exhibit and was asked if I could take some photos of the exhibit for pay. I stated that I could, and I did, as you can see. I delivered the photos to the Checker Dealership on Plymouth Road in Detroit. They accepted



the photos and I was paid. Little did I know that these photos would have value after so many years." John goes on to mention that for some reason he held onto these photos for almost 50 years, which included moving four times!

Looking at the photographs, my guess is that the year was 1964 because of the signs that appear at the display advertising that now you had two engine choices, "an economical '6' and a spirited V-8", as it was in 1964 that Checker switched over to using Chevy engines and had the 327 V-8 as an option. Of course it is otherwise impossible to tell the date by the cars themselves, other than to say that they were 1960's models. We can only guess why the display included the bodiless frame. Probably to show how ruggedly it was constructed to go along with the "Built to Last" slogan on some of the display signs? I wonder how they got the frame delivered to the show?

In one of the photographs a Jeep wagon can be seen. Probably all the "independent" manufacturers were clustered together in the hall as at that time Jeep was independent too (AMC purchased Jeep in 1972).

I was impressed at all the visitors at the Checker

display. In one photo there were twenty people checking out the Checkers!

I was surprised by John's comment that he "delivered the photos to the Checker dealership on Plymouth Road in Detroit". Maybe Checker engaged a local dealer to display at the auto shows instead of it being done by the factory in Kalamazoo? That would make sense. I had heard of this dealership and have a photograph of it as it currently exists in the Checker Car Club web site photo gallery. It seems that it was the only one in Detroit.

So, at a chance meeting at a car show, my question about Checker's participation at auto shows was answered by someone who was not only there but took photographs and saved them for almost 50 years! Thanks, John Stewart.

By the way, John is a Datsun / Nissan collector. He owns a 1970 240Z, a 1972 240Z, a 1985 300Z, a 1990 300ZX, and a 1995 300ZX Twin Turbo.

The photos are used with John Stewart's permission. He suggested using Photoshop to clean up the age cracks but the "raw" photos were just fine.

1983 CHECKER ... CONTINUED

As expected, the article on the 1983 generated some responses. Former CMC executive John Logan sent an explanation for the 9 inch 'B' pillar. With some minor editing, here is John's note:

"We were having trouble with the 9 inch longer door on the A-11E & A-12E's sagging due to the center pillar not being strong enough. Our engineering department tried different ways to correct this problem, including adding a spring loaded wedge to the bottom of the door & a stainless steel plate on the sill plus reinforcing the center pillar, none of which worked. I asked David if I could build a car with a regular rear door & a second center pillar 9 inches rearwards. David OK'ed my request. I, along with the body shop foreman, built a body. I won't bore you with the extra parts & the resistance I encountered from Engineering. The car was finished minus some trim pieces & sent to Experimental. The added parts & processes caused much resentment from Engineering. I got busy with three plants to cover, and forgot about this special car. It sat over at Cab Service for many months. Bill Spencer, a retired trimmer who worked for me in the trim shop and at that time worked in Cab Service part time, finished the trim and the car was sold. THE CAR WAS NOT A 1983. No cars were built on the Checker line after the cab at the Gilmore museum. We did refurbish a bunch of Chicago cabs after production stopped in 82."

As I was finishing up the proofing of this newsletter, John Logan sent me a second email with additional information. Here is what he added (with some minor editing that does not affect the content or context):

"I finally checked the chassis number for subject Checker, 1CMS4121BK001975, and found only 16 digits. Should be 17. It appears the 4th digit (M for Marathon model) is missing. The 5th digit is wrong, should be E, not S. The 9th digit should be an X. The 10th digit is model year which is a B for 1981. Digits 12 thru 17 are the chassis number, which tells me this Checker was the 1975th job built in 1981. Whom ever is saying this is a 1983 Checker is a fraud. I was given a copy of your article in the Checker news letter which I found very interesting. Not factual, but interesting. As we talked the other day, the 9 inch center pillar was

actually two center pillars on each side. The car wasn't built for any particular person, it was an experiment. It was not the last A-12E manufactured. It was not built from spare parts by three employees. The car was built by all the Checker line employees. The only difference was the body came out of the balloon jig and was set off the line so we could add the second pillar on each side. We added a flat panel from the belt line up to the pillars on each side. A front door skin was cut to length & hemmed on both sides & welded to the pillars from the belt line down to the rocker. The body was dropped on a E chassis & continued down the line, until completed. The only other special part was a trim panel to cover the wide pillar on each side. The car sat over at Cab Service for some time. Finally Bill Spencer, a retired trimmer built and installed a fancier trim, seats, door panels, carpet and other interior panels, and the car was sold. The present owner must have customized it. By the way, why is the front door inside handle installed backwards?"

According to the information the editor received at both the 2009 Gilmore event and prior to it, along with Bill Spenser, Andy Kimball was also somehow involved in finishing the car.

As regular visitors to Cab Service were aware, in the years after 1982 a number of restorations were done in the facility. Over the years some of us, including the editor, were lucky enough to get a personal tour of Cab Service by Bob Chamberlain.

So now we know why the large 9 inch pillar exists - to stop sagging of the E models doors. We also know that the major assembly work was done in 1981, long before the assembly line was shut down in July of 1982, and apparently finished and titled in 83.

The practice of titling unsold previous model year cars as new current year models was, at one time, a fairly common practice among limited production manufacturers such as Shelby, Bricklin, DeLoren, etc. In most of those cases they were dealing with serial numbers, not VINs. Serial numbers do not contain a year identification, so they could be reused. By law, VINs do contain a year identifier. Apparently a 1983 VIN was cobbled together so the car could be sold as new in 1983. I'd love to know that part of the story.

Even though the car was built in 1981 and finished later, with a 1983 VIN I'm sure the Department of Motor Vehicles considers it a 1983 model.

Now, the major unsolved mystery is why was this car finished for Neil Rosenstein in 1983?


