Subject: APPEARANCE - MODEL A-9

Description: MAINTENANCE OF FLOORS IN SHOP AREAS

Maintenance of floor surfaces in shop areas, particularly in motor repair and inspection areas, increases the value of quality repairs and inspection in these two departments.

An excellent procedure is to periodically paint the floors in these areas with a terra cotta paint. The application of this paint should be made approximately four times per year for a hard, lustered finish.

A simple and economical method of applying this paint is to immerse an O-Cedar mop in a 5-gallon bucket of paint and apply the paint to the floor surface. In this manner, an ample amount of material is placed on the floor.

An area of approximately 600 square feet can be completed in the minimum time of 25 minutes. Painting of floors adds to general appearance of all shops.
