TRANSMISSION - MODEL A-9

Description: FLUID CHANGE ON AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION

As mileage accumulation progresses on cars equipped with automatic transmission, it is very essential that lubricant supplied through the various transmission components is maintained at peak efficiency.

It is therefore recommended that transmission fluid be drained at 15,000 miles. Also included in this drain process should be the removal and thorough cleaning of transmission oil screen.

Converters should also be completely drained during this mileage interval.

- 1. Remove pan.
  - 2. Clean pan with gasoline or naphtha.
    - 3. Thoroughly wash screen mesh with Bendix or Greasemaster solution.
    - Replace pan with new gasket and refill 4. transmission with approved fluid.
    - 5. Inspect shift and control linkage and adjust, if necessary.
