GENERAL INFORMATION

This Parts Catalogue has been published by the Checker Cab Manufacturing Corporation to serve as a guide for identifying, selecting and procuring service parts for the "Checker" Model A8 Car through the use of installation illustrations keyed to associated parts list and the adherence to the service parts ordering procedure outlined herein.

To simplify the location of Chassis and Body Service Parts, the catalogue has been divided into two sections, namely; a Chassis Section and a Body Section. The service installations contained in each of these sections are identified by Group Numbers. Example: Frame-Chassis - Group 1, Suspension-Front - Group 2, Suspension-Rear - Group 3, Front Exterior-Body - Group 26 etc. These service installations are readily located in both the Chassis and Body Sections through the use of a "Quick Reference Index" which precedes each section.

The rapid location of service installation component parts, in both the Chassis and Body Sections, is ascertained through the use of the following references:

1. Service installation illustrations keyed to associated parts list. Each service part listed in the parts list that appears in a service installation illustration is preceded by an illustration key number. This number first indicates the number of the service installation illustration in which the particular service part is shown. Secondly, the number appearing after the dash in the key number identifies the service part in the service installation illustration.
2. The following reference indexes have been provided at the back of the catalogue for both the Chassis and Body Sections:
 - A. Service Installation Alphabetical Index; indicating Group Number, Illustration Number and Parts List page number.
 - B. Service Parts Numerical Index; indicating Installation Illustration Key Number and Page Number on which same is located.
 - C. Service Parts Alphabetical Index; indicating Installation Illustration Key Number, Part Number and Page Number on which same is located.
 - D. Standard Parts Numerical Index (Bolts, washers, nuts, etc.); indicating Description and Size.

NOTATION: Service Installation Group Numbers, 20 through 24, and Service Installation Illustration Numbers, 53 through 59, have been omitted from this publication to cover future Parts and Service Bulletin Supplements.

Service part description indentations appearing in the Parts Catalogue indicate that the indented part is included in the service assembly under which it is indented. Example:

GENERAL INFORMATION (cont'd)

Both the PLUG and the CYLINDER are included with the CYLINDER ASSEMBLY. However, the PLUG can be purchased separately under part number 444571, while the CYLINDER, which is preceded by N.S.S. in place of the part number is only furnished with the CYLINDER ASSEMBLY under part number 64759. All service parts listed in the Parts Catalogue, preceded by N.S.S., which indicates "Not Serviced Separately", are only furnished in the service assembly under which the indentation occurs.

SERVICE PARTS ORDERING INSTRUCTIONS.

1. Orders for service parts should be entered on our "Customers Original Order" blanks which are furnished gratis on request.
2. The following information is necessary to process orders correctly and promptly at our Service Parts Warehouse:
 - A. QUANTITY: Always list the exact number of pieces desired. Parts should not be ordered in "sets" or "pairs" except where listed, as these terms are indefinite and result in confusion during order processing.
 - B. PART NUMBER AND DESCRIPTION: List the part description as well as the part number when writing orders. Descriptions such as "Gasket" or "Bracket" are not sufficient. We are not responsible for errors in shipments unless part description as shown in this manual, in conjunction with the part number, is listed on orders.
 - C. CAR SERIAL NUMBER: The Serial Number, Body Number and Engine Number are stamped on an aluminum plate attached to the dash panel under the right side of the hood. When ordering body parts, list Body Number. List the Engine Number and Car Serial Number when ordering engine and chassis parts.
 - D. WHERE AND HOW TO SHIP: List Street Address, Postal Zone Number, City and State. Advise how you wish shipment made: Parcel Post, Express, Freight, Air Express or Parcel Post Special Delivery.
 - E. ADDRESS ORDER TO OUR SERVICE PARTS WAREHOUSE: Cab Service & Parts Corporation, 315 West 68th Street, New York City 23, New York.

ORDERING BY TELEGRAPH.

1. Part numbers may be expressed in code by using the following letters as substitutes for the corresponding figures:

2. When part numbers are expressed in code, the number required should be spelled out to avoid confusion between the number required and the part number.
3. We recommend the use of straight messages in preference to code and request that every telegraphic order be confirmed in writing. We handle all telegraphic orders just as the telegram reads when it reaches us and assume no liability for error.
4. The telegraph companies permit the use of code only in straight day or night messages and not in day or night letters.
5. The following utility code will greatly reduce the number of words required to order parts by telegraph:

6. The following example illustrates the use of the code:

“Ship to us by parcel post special delivery one 64759 Reverse Brake Cylinder Assembly two 444571 Reverse Brake Cylinder Pipe Plugs for serial number 16025” (26 words).

“BENIA one NOIRH two 000RID Stop BUNKA DNTAR” (9 words as a straight message).

TERMS.

All parts are shipped either C.O.D. or billed to our order with Bill Of Lading attached to Sight Draft, F.O.B. our warehouse.

RETURNING MATERIAL.

1. Returned material tags and forms are furnished gratis on request by the Cab Service and Parts Corporation, and must be used whenever parts are returned for adjustment or for credit. Each part must be tagged and listed separately with full information. **TRANSPORTATION CHARGES MUST BE PREPAID ON ALL MATERIAL RETURNED TO Cab Service and Parts Corporation, 315 West 68th Street, New York City 23, New York.**
2. New material and material which has failed in service must be listed separately by type and on separate reports. Invoice number must be listed with any new parts returned for credit, otherwise credit investigation cannot be made.



GENERAL INFORMATION (cont'd)

CLAIMS.

1. Claims for shortage of parts on a shipment must be made within twenty-four hours after delivery and must be made against the carrier. Before the Consignee accepts and signs for a shipment, he should examine the shipment for abusive handling. If packing cases are broken or show evidence of rough handling he should refuse shipment unless carrier signs the freight bill indicating damage.
2. A packing slip accompanies each shipment and the parts are double checked against the packing slip before shipment leaves our warehouse.

WARRANTY

"The Manufacturer warrants each new motor vehicle manufactured by it to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service, its obligation under this warranty being limited to making good at its factory any part or parts thereof, including all equipment or trade accessories (except tires) supplied by the Motor Vehicle Manufacturer, which shall, within ninety (90) days after making delivery of such vehicle to the original purchaser or before such vehicle has been driven four thousand (4,000) miles, whichever event shall first occur, be returned to it with transportation charges prepaid, and which its examination shall disclose to its satisfaction to have been thus defective; this warranty being expressly in lieu of all other warranties expressed or implied and of all other obligations or liabilities on its part, and it neither assumes nor authorizes any other person to assume for it any liability in connection with the sale of its vehicles.

This warranty shall not apply to any vehicle which shall have been repaired or altered outside of any authorized Checker service station in any way so as, in the judgment of the Manufacturer, to effect its stability or reliability, nor which has been subject to misuse, negligence or accident."
