

GROUP 10 — ENGINE**ENGINE IDENTIFICATION**

Listed below are the Checker Engine Specification Numbers and corresponding Chevrolet Engine Identification Numbers which are shown on the Serial Number Plate located on the left side of the cowl under the hood.

The Engine Identification Numbers (as shown

below — along with five (5) additional digits indicating manufacturing plant and built date) are stamped on the right hand side on the distributor pad on 6 cylinder engines and on the top front of the right hand bank of the cylinder and case assembly on 8 cylinder engines.

Another means of engine identification is the letter following the vehicle serial number (suffix). See examples below. The vehicle serial number can be

found on the Serial number Plate under the hood or on the Certification Plate located on the left front door pillar post.
