SUBJECT: USAGE OF SURPLUS MODEL A-9 REAR SEAT CUSHION SPRINGS
FOR MODEL A-12 LIMOUSINE.

1. The surplus cushion springs involved are to be reworked for use on Model A-12 Limousine as will be shown on drawing to be prepared by Body Engineering.
2. The 87 surplus 633015 Spring Assem-Rear Seat Cushion will be reworked to make 641004 Spring Assem-Rear Seat Cushion-Limo.
3. The 164 surplus 637100 Spring Assem-Rear Seat Cushion (coil) will be reworked to make 641005 Spring Assem-Rear Seat Cushion-Limo.(coil)
4. The spring assemblies 641004 and 641005 will be interchangeable for service and production.. Rework all the surplus 633015 before reworking 637100.
