SUBJECT: SILVER PLATING ON "DOUGLAS" WIRING TERMINAL

We have just received information to the effect that Douglas terminals requiring silver plate finish will be numbered with a suffix "S" and the plain brass part will be furnished when the distinction is not indicated. The plain brass part costs approximately ten per cent less.

A rejection by Inspection resulted in correspondence in this matter and the amounts involved are too small to warrant long discussion. This rejected material is useable, but it is the belief of the writer that our best interests will be served if we reserve the use of these parts for those assemblies in which the joints will be soldered.
