SUBJECT: FRONT SUSPENSION COIL SPRINGS

As soon as #702327 is available the following classification becomes effective.

702327 will cover all B-11 & B-12 6 cylinder models whereby the mean-to-high limit version (Brown stripe only) should be used when air conditioning is installed.

92292 will cover all B-11 & B-12 V-8 Models with or without air conditioning as well as B-12E V-8 Models without air conditioning.

98506 will cover B-12E Models with air conditioning.

Tentatively next B-12E models for export with 6 cylinder engines should be equipped with 92292 springs, which then after approval by this office will be released as such.
